Publication of the Information Security Act (ZInfV-1)

6 June 2025 – On 4 June 2025, the Information Security Act (ZInfV-1) was published in the Official Gazette of the Republic of Slovenia, No. 40/25. It will enter into force on 19 June 2025. ZInfV-1 represents a significant step in strengthening cybersecurity in the Republic of Slovenia and introduces a more comprehensive regulation of the national information security system. The Act transposes the European Directive (EU) 2022/2555 (NIS 2) into Slovenian law and sets out rules for improving the security of networks and information systems.

ZInfV-1 introduces several important novelties, among which the following are highlighted:

- Expansion of the scope of obligated entities
- Obligation of self-registration
- Additional risk management measures
- Implementation of compliance assessments and self-assessments
- Regular training of responsible persons
- Establishment of coordinated vulnerability disclosure
- Strengthening trust in ICT products, services, and processes

A FAQ section is also available to help obligated entities better understand and implement the provisions of the Act.
