

151 digital hubs in the EU, two in Slovenia

The European Union is promoting digital transformation in the business and public sectors. It is co-funding 151 Digital Hubs (EDIHs) in 31 countries. In Slovenia, there are two EDI Hubs, one in Maribor and one in Novo mesto.

The hubs help businesses and entrepreneurs, as well as public institutions, to make the digital transformation. This includes the implementation of modern information systems, automation of processes and the introduction of advanced technological solutions, which increase the efficiency, competitiveness and adaptability of business and public institutions.

The Hubs not only promote technological progress, but also act as a catalyst for the development of a culture of innovation. The financial resources invested in the Hubs allow for the creation of an environment where creativity, collaboration and the testing of new ideas are encouraged. This will strengthen our ability to adapt to rapid changes in the marketplace and stimulate innovative solutions to improve our business and our lives. Slovenia has two digital hubs. One is in Maribor, at the University of Maribor, and the other in Novo mesto, at the Development Centre of Novo mesto.

The common goal of the SRC-EDIH Digital Hub in Novo mesto, with 16 partners, is to strengthen digital transformation at all levels. Businesses, entrepreneurs and public institutions are invited to use the Hub. The Hub offers useful solutions, expert support and a range of professional events and trainings to help them overcome their own digital transformation challenges.
