

Systemic challenges of quality in the era of digitalisation and cyber security

The Section for Quality of the Chamber of Commerce of Dolenjska and Bela Krajina (GZDBK) organised the 26th Quality Day on 11 December. It addressed the challenges of digitisation, cyber security and management systems in the modern business environment.

The event opened with a welcome address by Igor Cesar, President of the Section for Quality at GZDBK (Head of Quality at REVOZ, d.d.), and Tomaž Kordiš, Manager of GZDBK. The programme of the day consisted of five expert presentations in which the speakers shared their knowledge and experience. Klemen Kindlhofer from Danfoss Trata, d.o.o. presented the link between digitisation of work processes and cyber security and their impact on quality. Anton Petrič from TPV Automotive, d.o.o. highlighted the role of management systems in meeting the challenges of the future. Primož Verčič, consultant from DSE / TOMAS Group, shared an example of a successful implementation of advanced tools to improve operations and quality in the automotive industry. Matjaž Šlibar, Quality Technologist at Kolektor Etra, also presented a practical example of the implementation of business and quality improvement tools. Jana Kolenc Muženič from SIQ Ljubljana summarised the new developments and trends in ISO 9001 and their role in quality management. The Quality Day was concluded by Igor Cesar with his final thoughts.
