

The European Commission co-finances two projects in Slovenia to promote the digitization of companies and other organizations

In the fall, Slovenia successfully obtained European Union funds for two prominent consortia for the implementation of various digitization promotion measures. In Maribor, part of the SRC-EDIH consortium took part in a conference organized by EDIH-SI.

Following the opening remarks, conference attendees listened to a keynote speech by Lisa-Ann Sheahan on supporting manufacturing companies in their digital innovation efforts. This was followed by a welcome from the EDIH DIGI-SI coordinator (M. Turkanović) and a round table where EDIH DIGI-SI services were presented. In the continuation of the conference, some facts and obstacles that digital transformation brings to the economy, the state and local communities, and last but not least, the people of Slovenia, were highlighted. During the guided discussion, the guests presented the complementarity of services with other supporting institutions and initiatives.

The final digital innovations of the Digital Innovation Challenge - PITCH were brought before the international commission and the winner was announced. The introductory meeting of the EDIH DIGI-SI advisory board and the ADMA Trans4mers event and digitization of production processes were also held in parallel.
